<b>Land</b>	Close contact with others in the compound	Social distancing of 2m must be observed.	Wearing of face masks is recommended.
	Opening gate	Wear gloves to avoid directly handling locker door, gate or key.	Follow Government hygiene guidelines.
	Changing	Clubhouse closed.	Change outside or arrive changed.
	Toilets	Clubhouse closed.	
	Hose	Wear gloves to avoid directly handling tap or hose.	Follow Government hygiene guidelines.
At this time we ask that all members assess the conditions for sailing with a greater degree of caution than usual. In these times we want to minimise the chances of a scenario that would involve the support of others and more specifically the emergency services.			
<b>Water</b>	Gear failure	Take additional time to check likely failure points whilst rigging.	Carry out repairs, and replace kit, that is identified as a likely failure point.
	Sailing a boat with someone from another household	Not permitted at the moment.	
	Sailing with someone from another household	Social distancing of 2m must be observed.	Follow Government hygiene guidelines.
	Launching and recovery	You should be able to launch and recover your boat to the compound by yourself, with the help of members of your own household or 2m apart from one other person from another household.	Make use of club slipway fixed point if beach is difficult to cross. ** The club pulley system will not be available for use so you would need your own.
	Offshore wind	Recommend only to 15 knots. This is the wind in the bay area and not ashore.	Use SBSC and Bramblemet weather stations. Local or attending members use Facebook to share Solent/bay conditions.
	Heavy wind	Recommend only to 18 knots (not offshore)	Use SBSC and Bramblemet weather stations. Local or attending members use Facebook to share Solent/bay conditions.
	Novice sailing	Recommend only to 12 knots (not offshore)	Use SBSC and Bramblemet weather stations. Local or attending members use Facebook to share Solent/bay conditions.
	First aid (but not an emergency)	Clubhouse closed.	Bring your own first kit.
Emergency	CALL 999 and ask for 'Coastguard' or VHF CH16 and call a 'mayday or panpan' . Carry a mobile phone with the numbers of a suitable onshore contact, SBSC office (weekdays) in an accessible place.	Be considerate and conservative when deciding to go afloat.
