



What has changed in the last 3 years?

Sailing and Race Management



- Slipway matting and the Wadsworth Winch (thanks to Richard for this!)
- We've got a booking system for club boats
- We introduced Watersports membership
- Big safety improvements around event planning e.g. Open Meeting and Round
 The Forts races
- Our RIBs and their trolleys are in tip-top condition
- The Bridge Manual has been completely updated
- The Race Officer's job has been simplified
- We've got the bridge camera with a live feed to the website
- We revamped the bridge layout
- Race results and series results get posted promptly and reliably after racing

- You can pick your own duty dates
- You can book online for events
- You can pay online too
- We've implemented Safeguarding
- We've introduced e-membership cards
- You can use the clubroom 5 days a week (4 in winter)
- You can use the bar every Friday and Wednesday evening through the year
- On Foodie Fridays you can enjoy home-cooked specials from the galley

Facilities:

- We've got a refurbished clubroom and bar:
 - Flooring
 - Walls

 - Trophy cabinet
 - Bar equipment
 - Two TVs (replacing old projector and screen)
- We've got a smart new disabled WC and baby change downstairs
- The lobby and stairwell have had a makeover
- We've got PIR-controlled lighting throughout the ground floor
- The sail store and garage have been refurbished
- We've got a new shed for one of the RIBs
- We've got a new secure storage area for kayaks and anything else
